▶ 3. Eligibility Criteria

Nationality:

- The applicant should be a Resident/ Non-Resident Indian National/ PIO/OCI.
- Foreign applicants who studied/studying abroad can apply directly through the international application form. (www.lnctu.ac.in | www.jnctpu.edu.in | www.lnctvu.ac.in)

• Age Limit:

- Applicants whose date of birth falls on or after 1st July 2002 are eligible to apply for admission in all UG Courses admission 2024.
- The date of birth as recorded in the High School /SSC/X Certificate will be considered authentic. Applicants should produce these certificates in original as proof of their age at the time of counseling /admission, failing which their candidacy for admission will be disgualified.

Qualifying Examination:

Applicants applying for UG Courses admission should have either completed or shall be appearing in 2024, in any one of the following qualifying examinations:

- The final examination of the 10+2 system of higher secondary examination conducted by the State Board; Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE, New Delhi), The Council for Indian School Certificate Examination (ISCE), New Delhi.
- Intermediate or Two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board/University.
- Regular 'NIOS' board candidates are also eligible for Undergraduate programmes. Applicants should produce the Migration Cum Transfer Certificate at the time of joining.

Requirement of Qualifying Examination

Applicants applying for admission to all the Undergraduate Courses in 2024 should have secured minimum aggregate of 60% in the qualifying examination (+2/Intermediate).









- For Indian nationals attending LNCTCET 2024 it is mandatory to be eligible for **UG courses admission**.
- In case LNCTCET 2024 gets cancelled due to natural calamities, qualifying criteria may be substituted with higher secondary marks. Applicants will be informed with specifics in such case.



Subject Eligibility

- PCMB/PCM applicants who have attempted Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, English and Aptitude (MPCEA) in LNCTCET 2024 are eligible for B.Tech/BCA/BBA/B.Com/B.Pharmacy/D.Pharmacy/BPES/BHMCT/BBA-HHA/BALLB/BBALLB/BJMC/B.Sc.(Hons.) Agri. Programmes.
- PCB applicants who have attempted Biology, Physics, Chemistry, English and Aptitude (MPCEA) in LNCTCET 2024 are eligible for B.Sc. Nursing/BPT/BMLT/DMLT/All Technician Courses/B.Pharmacy/D.Pharmacy/BCA/BBA/B.Com/BALLB/BJMC/B.Sc.(Hons.) Agri. Programmes.
- Commerce/Arts applicants who have attempted English and Aptitude (MPCEA) in LNCTCET 2024 are eligible for BA/BBA/B.Com/BPES/BHMCT/BBA-HHA/BALLB/BBALLB/BJMC Programmes.
- Agriculture applicants who have attempted English and Aptitude (MPCEA) in LNCTCET 2024 are eligible for B.Sc.(Hons.)

 Agri. Programme.



▶ 4. About LNCTCET

LNCTCET 2024 will be conducted four times. The exam dates for LNCTCET 2024 are (27 & 28 April)*, (25 & 26 May)*, (29 & 30 June)* and (27 & 28 July)* for all Sessions respectively. Candidates can appear for all or either one of the four exam sessions.

LNCTCET 2024 registration is expected to begin in the second week of March 2024. The registration link will be activated on the official websites: (www.lnctu.ac.in | www.inctpu.edu.in | www.lnctvu.ac.in)



▶ 5. Online Application Form

The LNCTCET Application Form is available online at www.lnctu.ac.in | www.jnctpu.edu.in | www.lnctvu.ac.in. The Cost of the Application Form is Rs. 1,600/-, which will be Non-refundable.

Guidelines for filling up the application form:

New User Registration Process

- Valid e-mail address and active mobile number are required.
- Enter all the relevant details carefully.
- An OTP will be sent to your Registered Indian Mobile Number for verification.
- Once OTP is validated, a password will be sent to your registered email address.
- All the correspondence shall be made to the registered email address and mobile number only.

Sign-in for Registered Users

Valid e-mail address and active mobile number are required.

How to Fill online application form

- Fill in the relevant fields carefully. An Application Number will be generated after filling primary details.
- Refer this application number in all your future correspondence



Payment

Application fee of Rs. 1,600 should be paid through Net Banking Account/ Credit/Debit Card/ UPI **Note:** Application fee is non-refundable.

Photo and Signature Upload

The photograph must be in colour and should be taken professionally in a studio with the following specifications

- The photograph must be taken against a light coloured background. Only White/off-white background is preferred.
- The photograph must show the full-frontal view without tilting of face, both ears visible, open eyes with neutral expression.
- Make sure there is no glare from spectacles and no blur in the focus.
- The file should only be in JPEG format.
- The file size of the photograph should be within 20 kB to 300 KB.
- The photograph's dimension should be of Width (300 to 400 pixels) X Height (400 to 550 pixels).
- The photograph should not be too dark or too bright but should have optimum exposure.
- The photograph should have only one face.

Signature uploading procedure

- Please draw a rectangular box of size 6 cm (width) X 2 cm (height) on a A4 size white paper. Sign with a dark blue or black pen within the box.
- Scan the signature in (jpeg format) using scanner and crop the image.
- You can open the scanned signature image with MS Paint and crop the image at the particular rectangular box which was already marked and signed on the A4 size white paper.
- While cropping the image, make sure that the dimension should be 3.5 cm (width) X1.5 cm (height).
- The image size of scanned signature should be within 20 kB to 300 kB.

How to download filled-in application form

- Download and save the filled-in application for your future reference and further correspondence.
- Applicants NEED NOT SEND hard copy of the filled-in application form to LNCTU/JNCTPU/LNCTVU.

▶ 7. Selection Criteria



- Selection will be based on the rank secured through LNCTCET 2024.
- Selected candidates can participate in offline counseling based on their ranking. They can give options for specific programme and category of fees. Allotment will be based on the rank obtained, preference given and availability of seats during offline counselling.
- LNCTU/JNCTPU/LNCTVU will verify the eligibility of candidates after completing the tuition fee payment on or before the stipulated date. Candidates are required to produce documents on the day of reporting to the campus or as and when asked for, by the Office of Admissions. Provisional Admission offered during counselling will be valid ONLY if the eligibility is fulfilled.
- If a candidate had missed the chance to appear in LNCTCET, they may still be eligible to attend College Level Counseling (CLC) based on their qualifying base exam. However, their participation in CLC is subject to the availability of seats.



▶8. Admission Process for Candidates under NRI Category



- There will be no Entrance Examination for this category. Admission will be based on merit (marks/grades obtained in the qualifying examination-refer the Eligibility Norms) and availability of seats.

• Scrutiny of the documents received from the candidate

- Proof of Age & Nationality (Passport/Birth Certificate)
- Visa/Resident Card authenticating NRI status of parent
- 11th grade marksheet/AS Level/Form V(for appearing candidates) & 12th grade mark sheet/A Level/Form VI (for passed out candidates)
- Employer certificate (Optional at the time of application)

Issue of offer letter

- On satisfying all the eligibility requirements, the course/branch allotment order will be e-mailed to the registered email id.
- The provisional admission letter will be issued along with the fees structure. (only if the students meet the eligibility requirements)
- Allotment of course/branch will be done on the basis of the application and documents received from the candidate. The course/branch once allotted will not be changed under any circumstances.

Payment of Advance Fees

Selected candidates will be required to pay the Fees in USD as mentioned on the offer letter.

Payment of Balance Fees

The candidates are requested to pay the balance Tuition fee as per the provisional admission letter along with the copy of the XII mark statement / website copy (if available) / Copy of XII Hall Ticket or Admit card through Fund Transfer mode in USD.

• Information on other Admission Formalities

- On receipt of the balance fee, the details regarding the commencement of the programme and document submission will be informed through email.
- Candidates are requested to report to the University with the required original documents as per the provisional admission letter.

Payment of Hostel Fees

The hostel fees should be paid seperately along with the tuition fees.

- Copy of Provisional Letter (Optional)
- XII Mark statements of all attempts of qualifying examination
- Transfer Certificate / School leaving Certificate
- Migration Certificate (if issued by the board)
- Recent passport size colour photos 6 Nos.

Additional Documents required from NRI/Foreign students:

- Passport Copy (Student & Parent)
- Employer Certificate (original) if required
- Sponsorship letter (original) if required



▶ 10. Withdrawal & Refund Policy

- Fees once paid will be refundable as per College policies but will not be transferable.
- All refund requests must be submitted by the student/parents in writing addressed to the Principal, in person, by regular mail, or by email. The Principal shall acknowledge the receipt of the same. Telephone messages are NOT acceptable.
- All dues are need to be paid in order for the formalities of withdrawal to be completed.
- The fee refund will be solely based on the balance amount in the student's account after all applicable dues owed to the College are deducted. Discounts or concessions provided, may be void and may not apply upon withdrawal.
- The excess payment received through technical or other reasons will be refunded only after due verification and/or within 30 days after receipt of written complaint by the parent/student.
- The mode of refund will be electronic/physical and will be refunded in the account from where the transaction was made.
- The parents/students need to pay the payment gateway processing/convenience charges over and above the fees/dues payable to the College.
- Service tax applicable will be as notified by the Government from time to time and will also be added to the charges payable through the online payment gateway.
- The net amount will be refunded after deduction of transaction processing charges paid to the online payment gateway.
- No interest will be paid on a refund of any fees/deposit.
- Student should contact College authorities first, regarding any excess or double payment made by them.
- The refund of any fee will be subject to the refund policy prevailing at the time of seeking a refund.
- The College reserves the right to modify and amend refund policies at any time by uploading the same in the College's website
- All disputes will be subjected to the legal jurisdiction of District Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh, (India).
