


Medical Student Dr. Sarthak Jain from LNMC & J.K. Hospital Makes Strides in Robotic Surgery at Japan's Renowned Kameda Medical Center

Dr. Sarthak Jain, a medical student from L.N. Medical College & J.K. Hospital Bhopal, was one of only two Indian students selected for MBBS training in robotic gastroenterological surgery and general internal medicine. He trained at Kameda Medical Center in Japan, the first Japanese hospital accredited by the Joint Commission International (JCI) and ranked 45th globally among the world's best hospitals. During his time at Kameda, Dr. Sarthak assisted in and performed surgeries using the Da Vinci Robot, making India proud with his accomplishments.

In addition to his medical training, Dr. Sarthak is the founder and chairperson of the Genesis Organization, an NGO dedicated to human welfare and social health.
