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Notification Fellowship / Scholarship Policy for Ph.D./Research Scholars

Under the Provision of University Grant Commission (UGC) minimum standards and procedures for award of Ph.D. Degree Regulation 2022 and UGC Guidelines on public self-disclosure by higher Education Institutions 2024. The Vice Chancellor has constituted Fellowship / Scholarship Policy for Ph.D./ Research Scholars

1. Objective

The Fellowship/Scholarship Policy aims to provide financial support to Ph.D. Research scholars to promote high-quality research, ensure academic continuity, and encourage innovative contributions to knowledge.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- The applicant must be enrolled as a full-time Ph.D. scholar in the University/Institute.
- Admission must be through the prescribed selection process (entrance examination, interview, or as per UGC/AICTE/INC/PCI/NMC/BCI/Paramedical Council/ Concerned council/Institutional guidelines etc.
- Scholars receiving any other fellowship (e.g., UGC-JRF, CSIR, ICSSR, ICMR, DBT, DST, or equivalent)
 are not eligible for this institutional fellowship.

3. Duration of Fellowship

- Fellowship is awarded for a maximum of three years, extendable to a fourth year subject to satisfactory
 progress and recommendation of the Research Advisory Committee.
- No fellowship shall be granted beyond four years.

4. Fellowship Amount

- Annual relaxation of 20 % of total fees of first year for Meritorious / Economically weaker students.
- 50 % of Patent publication fees sponsored by the university.
- Scholars availing hostel accommodation will be entitled to waiver/ concession in hostel fee as per institutional rules.

5. Renewal and Continuation

- Fellowship is renewed annually based on the scholar's performance in Progress Seminars, RDC/DRC reviews, and submission of progress reports.
- Unsatisfactory progress or violation of research integrity may lead to suspension or termination of fellowship.

6. Research Integrity and Compliance

- Scholars must strictly adhere to institutional Research Ethics Guidelines and submit work to Plagiarism
 Check before thesis submission.
- Any act of misconduct, plagiarism, or academic dishonesty will lead to immediate termination of fellowship.

7. Leave Rules

- Scholars may avail 30 days of leave per academic year with fellowship.
- Leave beyond the permissible limit will result in deduction of fellowship for that duration.
- Maternity/Paternity leave will be granted as per UGC/Gol guidelines.

8. Termination of Fellowship

The fellowship may be terminated in the following cases:

- Non-compliance with rules or unsatisfactory academic progress.
- Completion of Ph.D. or submission of thesis.
- Scholar leaving the program midway without approval.
- Misconduct, breach of research ethics, or providing false information.

9. Monitoring and Administration

- The fellowship will be administered by the Dean (Research) / Research Cell / Fellowship Committee of the Institution.
- All decisions regarding award, renewal, or termination shall be final and binding.
