He motivated the students with his practical insights on personal growth and confidence-building.


He explained how fear often holds individuals back and encouraged students to overcome with stage fear by taking the first step forward. To make his point interactive, he asked students to choose between two options:

The interactive session encouraged students to ask questions, reflect on their career goals, and gain clarity on


aligning academic learning with industry requirements. Mr Pagare advised them to enhance their employability through internships, live projects, and certifications, while continuously developing soft skills.

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
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
