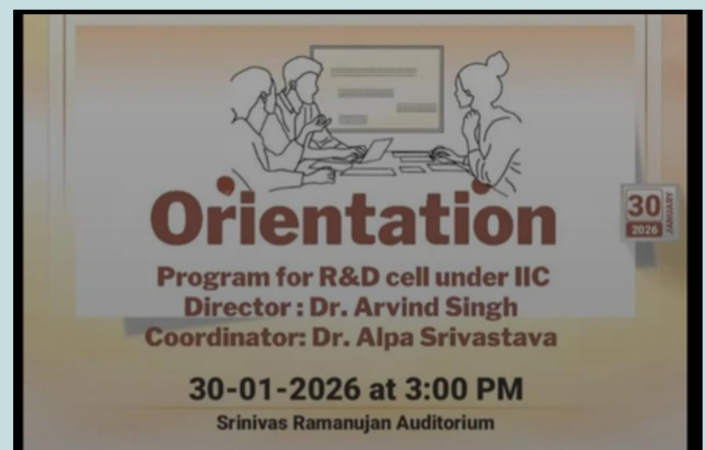
The atmosphere was full of inspiration as participants discussed nationalism, the sacrifices of our brave soldiers, and the collective vision for a future India.

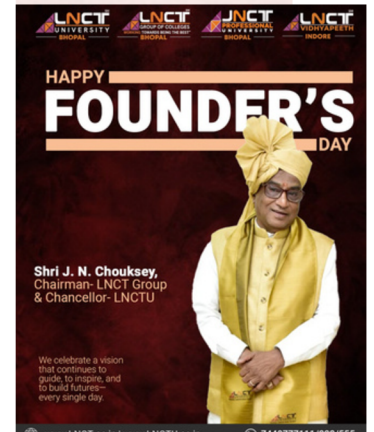

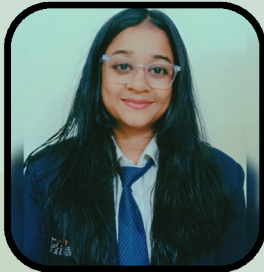
