

- I. **Fees Submission date:** by 5 March 2022. After that with late fees. All the fees are to be paid online via College ERP for contactless transactions.
- II. **Registration for Semester:** The College will remove the name of students, who have not completed online registration process by 5 March, 2022. Such students will not be allowed to appear in university examinations. Link will be available on student portal.
- III. **Book Bank- Issue Dates:** Books will be issued from library only after submission of fee on 25th and 26th Feb, 2022. Books will not be issued after the specified dates. Library books should be returned within five days after the end of University examinations.
- IV. **Mid Semester Exam I & Mid Semester Exam II:** Dates to be announced later.
- V. **Extra Curricular Activities:** Sports, Quiz, academic & Cultural Events: Dates will be notified from time to time.
- VI. **Internship /Industrial training** for all years as per university syllabus shall have to be completed by students.
- VII. Classes will start offline on campus as per Govt. orders.
- VIII. Students are advised to complete the vaccination process for Covid-19 (As per eligibility).

1. 100% Course coverage to be ensured by 15/6/2022.

Maximum permissible absence from classes (for any reason what so ever e.g., illness, social function, sports or other participation etc.) shall be strictly in accordance to the Ordinance for Diploma (Engg). of LNCT University, Bhopal.
